## Bolton Conservation in Bolton

Special tips for this location: Parking area is around 178 Main Street, Bolton, MA off the main road, with 8-9 car spots for the start of the Bob Horton Trail. There are several other parking options- please check out the link provided below for alternatives. Bring a copy of the map and use your trail app because there are several intersecting trails to wander through and discover.

Highlights of the hiking area include passing many points of interest such as quarry workings and the Lime Kiln. Another site to see includes the Sawyer Grist Mill remnants. (The remains of the mill can be seen at the end of a secondary trail that diverges from the main trail between junctions 3E and 2M - check out the map)

Dogs are allowed but must be kept on leash. Lace up your hiking boots (pack your microspikes), grab mosquito and tick spray if it's warm, dress in layers, bring a copy of the map, grab a snack and water - ENJOY!
