Special tips for this location: Main parking lot is free and at 1361 Middleboro Ave., East Taunton, Ma. Check the map for other parking options if needed.

Highlights of this space include: Cranberry bogs, many ponds to fish in, mountain biking, and boating!

Hike idea: Check out the blazed trails [here](#) to create your own day of hiking. Or for an idea; try Adams Trail, to 5 pond loop, to forest trail to park road. If you don't feel like walking, bring your bike and bike the trails!

Dogs allowed but must be kept on leash the whole time, lace up your hiking boots (pack your microspikes if icy), pack up your mountain bike, grab mosquito and tick spray if it's warm, dress in layers, bring a copy of the map, have your trail app ready, bring a snack and water bottle — ENJOY!
