Maudslay State Park in Newburyport

Special tips for this location: Parking lot is at 74 Curzon Mill Road, Newburyport, MA. It's a pretty big lot and there is a bathroom facility there. There is a daily parking rate of \$5.00/car for MA Residents and \$20.00/car for non-MA residents.

Highlights of this space include: Rolling meadows, beautiful views of the Merrimack River, 19th century gardens, and beautiful plants and trees. For extensive information on what is in bloom, click [here](#).

Lace up your hiking boots (pack your microspikes if icy), pack up your mountain bike, grab mosquito and tick spray if it's seasonably warm, dress in layers, bring a copy of the map, have your trail app ready, bring a snack and water bottle – ENJOY!
