



Walking in Massachusetts

Mount Pisgah, Northborough, Berlin, and Boylston

Special tips for this location: Parking lot is approximately at 24 Smith Road Northborough, MA. The lot can get busy, so plan accordingly.

Highlights of this space include: the possibility to view the Boston skyline on a clear day (at the North View at Tyler junction) and the possibility of unusual sightings of bobcat, black bear and moose because of the extensive wildlife corridor in the region.

Hike idea: Start on the Mentzer Trail, take a left on Berlin Road Trail, take a right onto Tyler Trail and make sure to check out the overlook to get a chance to see the Boston skyline. Continue on Tyler, take a right onto Sparrow, and a left onto Menzer back to your car.

Dogs allowed, please follow the rules stated in the detailed info pamphlet. Lace up your hiking boots (pack your microspikes), grab mosquito and tick spray if it's seasonably warm, dress in layers, bring a copy of the map, have your trail app ready, bring a snack and water bottle - ENJOY!
