



# Walking in Massachusetts

## Rocky Narrows, Sherborn

Special tips for this location: Free to all, 2 limited sized parking lots so have both location addresses handy and an alternative plan just in case. First lot is on Forest St. off Snow St. at the northern edge of the property (6 cars) and the second lot is on South Main Street (route 27). On-street parking is not permitted.

Check out the red trail loop and take a detour to King Philip's Overlook (blue trail) and if you are not tired add the orange loop! For canoe launch points into the Charles River, look at the trail map. Dogs are permitted off leash as long as they remain under control at all times. Please note that there is an active railway on the southwest corner of the property. Lace up your sneakers or hiking boots and grab your snack and water bottle — ENJOY!

Please leave your pets at home for this walk.
